Oxford Lieder relies on the invaluable support of the Friends of Oxford Lieder to ensure the continuation of the annual Festival and our year-round events. The basic subscription cost has been kept low, but the cumulative effect of the Friends makes a huge difference to our ongoing success.

We are delighted that **Ian Partridge**, who gave his “farewell” recital at the 2008 Lieder Festival, has agreed to be Patron of the Friends of Oxford Lieder. He will be leading this year’s master course and will also be involved in the Friends’ event early next year.

Benefits to Friends include:

Subscription Levels

Friends £30 (£40 joint subscription)

Songsters £50+

Wanderers £100+

Help support the pre-concert talks programme or community outreach work such as workshops & free ticket schemes for the disabled, disadvantaged and homeless.

Sweethearts £250+

Help support a Young Artist recital in the Festival, a project for community participation, commissioning of a new composition, or a Master Class.

Muses £1,000+

Support a Rising Star, either singer or pianist, a pair of daytime recitals, or early evening 'rush hour' performances in Oxford.

Heroes £2,500+

Support a Celebrity Recital, a particular aspect of the Festival such as a live CD recording, or a singing project for local primary school children

Those who choose to support at a higher level also qualify for certain additional benefits, such as:

- Acknowledgement as a supporter of a recital(s) or project
- Complimentary or discounted tickets to recitals
